INTRODUCTION

We are all in midst of a corona pandemic that had adversely affected the lives and livelihoods of billions of population across the world. The farming communities especially smallholder farmers have negatively affected by the disruption in the market system and supply chains. The studies on the impact of Covid 19 on value chains conducted by Value Chain Capacity Building Network (VCB-N) and International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) in Asia Pacific Regions in 2020 showed that the small and marginal farmers due to lesser endurance and buffer saving were affected the most. In this context that it has become more important to promote and scaling-up pro-poor value chains and market systems so as to ensure better price realization for their produce and also build their resilience towards risks and shocks in the future.

Worldwide, there is an increasing focus on promoting a pro-poor value chain and market development. IFAD which is one of the major agencies providing financial support for developing agriculture and allied sectors in Asia-Pacific regions has adopted this approach to ensure livelihood security of small producers including those residing in hilly, forested, and tribal areas. The online training aims to build the capacity of project staff/practitioners on the pro-poor value chain and market system development and also plan for risk management under situations like – Climate Change and Covid 19 Scenarios.

Institute of Livelihood Research and Training (ILRT) is an academic institution promoted by BASIX Social Enterprise Group which is conglomerate of livelihood promotion institutions in India. VCB-N conducted series of training of trainers (ToTs) to build the capacity of professionals of CoEs on organizing training for staff members of IFAD projects. The practical experience of VC & MSD included by ILRT based on long experience of knowledge building and dissemination on value chain development including value chain interventions made with BASIX and outside agencies.




OBJECTIVES OF THE TRAINING

The objective of the training is to provide frameworks and principles that help the planners and practitioners to conduct market systems analysis, designing interventions for sustainable and large-scale impacts, and monitoring and measuring results.

The specific objectives are:

- Acquire and deepen knowledge and skills on how to conduct good market analysis and translate analysis into designing successful interventions
- Learn about how to apply and integrate different tools in actual projects.
- Understand how to design and implement monitoring and results in measurement systems to know what works and what does not and why
- Access and share individual experiences on market analysis, intervention design, and monitoring



WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The curriculum targets project staff members/professionals who are involved in decision making, planning, and designing value chain and market system development interventions under Agri-Horti, agri-allied sectors such as dairy, goatery, poultry, fishery, piggery, and forestry sectors and other value-added production.

PEDAGOGY & MEDIUM

The training program will be organized online using the Zoom platform and shall use multiple methodologies of learning such as including interactive lectures, case discussions, group work, experience sharing & cross-learning, audio-visual presentations, short session value chain experts & practitioners. The medium of instruction will be English.

RESOURCE TEAM

The Resource team and facilitators are highly experienced professionals who are having experience in academics and practice on livelihood promotion including value chain and market analysis and development.

DURATION AND TIMING

The overall course duration will be 7 days which is two weeks. The training will be conducted online on a video-conferencing platform for 3 hours daily. In addition to this offline support will be extended to participants for analysis and design of propoor value chain and market systems.
